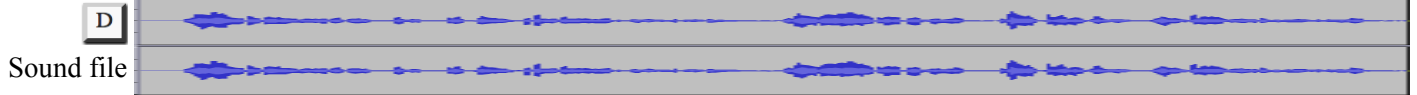


The Lake Isle of Innisfree
